With young people with disabilities


- Managing the demands of their life journey on a daily basis, **for a life of dignity** ;

- **Create a network of friends** and collaborators to accompany their life journey with us.






They have preceded us to the bosom of the Father this year...

This young man, brother of Barbara and suffering from the same handicap, was a member of Anta Akhi's family for some years. He now rests with his two brothers and his sister.




Rita Mounzer

A crazy year! In Lebanon and Anta Akhi

Amplified by the Covid-19 pandemic that brought the country to a standstill for several weeks, our usual activities were challenged.



Exceptional situations call for exceptional reactions: **The entire** Anta Akhi team has adapted to meet the needs of the young people and the house.

Some members of the team have adapted their jobs or changed functions in order to guarantee the sustainability of Anta Akhi's action.





Companions who do not hesitate to give of themselves...

It took a lot of love to decide to lock themselves up for several weeks with our young adults with disabilities! To limit the risks of Covid attacks, some of them were confined for several weeks, sometimes up to 33 days without leaving the house, working day and night, without seeing their families, while some of them have young children. They competed with ingenuity to continue to animate the house, to keep the link with the outside world and to allow everyone to experience joy despite the difficulties.



Many of them also offered shifts during the first part of the confinement. Thank you for so much love and commitment!




And a team fully mobilized around our youth

The General Service team on deck: Adapting schedules, changing jobs, working remotely or at the “Home of Tenderness”, all the necessary adjustments were made to ensure the smooth running of the house without forgetting good hygiene and good food.

No respite for the Fundraising and Donations Unit: Despite the cancellation of all the fundraising activities and the numerous interruptions due to the blocking of the roads and the confinement rules, the 3 collectors continued to criss-cross the roads of Lebanon to collect donations and sponsorships.

The search for international support continues: With calls for donations, the preparation of crowdfunding operations, the presentation of new funding projects and the maintenance of close relations with our donors outside Lebanon, the Communication and Projects Unit has worked tirelessly to ensure the sustainability of our income and to relay our action on social networks or through circulars.






Spiritual and existential accompaniment online, so as not to leave the youth without answers

After a period of latency, linked to the uncertainty of the aftermath of the confinement and to organizational imperatives, the individual and group follow-up of our youth with disabilities was able to continue by videoconference from June onwards ; a new method which, against all expectations, allowed us to do a more interesting work with each individual.

Also trainings for the able-bodied could take place with our visitors (before the confinement) and with various groups online, notably with the students of the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik (through a multi-year collaboration in the framework of a civic engagement course).


The spiritual accompaniment reached **229** children with disabilities in 30 groups.

Existential accompaniment reached **277** people as shown in the graph opposite.



Our action has been aimed at our young people with disabilities, but also at our visitors for a peaceful and joyful living together despite all difficulties. Their number went from 2200 last year to 1179 this year.

In spite of all the difficulties of the country and in spite of a strict confinement at Anta Akhi, we were able to allow our young adults to continue their life path in dignity.

With a lot of faith and confidence, while we only had prayer as a weapon, our "Home of Tenderness" became more than ever a small living "Cenacle" of prayer.

The result was not long in coming: thanks to the generosity coming from Lebanon and the 4 corners of the world, and while the situation of Anta Akhi remains fragile, we can attest to having lived a miracle year!

Little Alphonse gave us all the money in his piggy bank!




Kaya's baptism gifts have been given to us!

The Fitness Academy did not hesitate to help us during this difficult period.



Lionel, a DCC volunteer at Anta Akhi, mobilized his entire entourage to help us raise funds.




The Provictimis Foundation has agreed to change the use of the funds to help in the support of the youth



Our friends from the Fraternité Franciscaine de l'Est have blessed us with their messages of friendship and their donations.




Our friends, Lebanese-French volunteers of Anta Akhi France, are constantly mobilized to find new ways to help us.






By level of motor function

Follow-up of the youth's health

Our main objective is that our young people live a life of dignity on a daily basis, and this objective also includes health; we are always present with them so that, beyond all the planned programming, they can maintain their skills.

This year, the following activities were carried out:

- 41 health check-ups
- 24 consultations + 21 by phone
- 5 emergency consultations
- 5 hospitalizations for Barbara, Pierre, Marcelle and Samo
- 458 acts of physiotherapy
- 1033 acts of respiratory therapy


For our young people with disabilities living in their homes and unable to come to Anta Akhi physiotherapy sessions at home have been carried out by the physiotherapist, from June 2020.




Our team

of which 50 are full-time.


Age distribution
